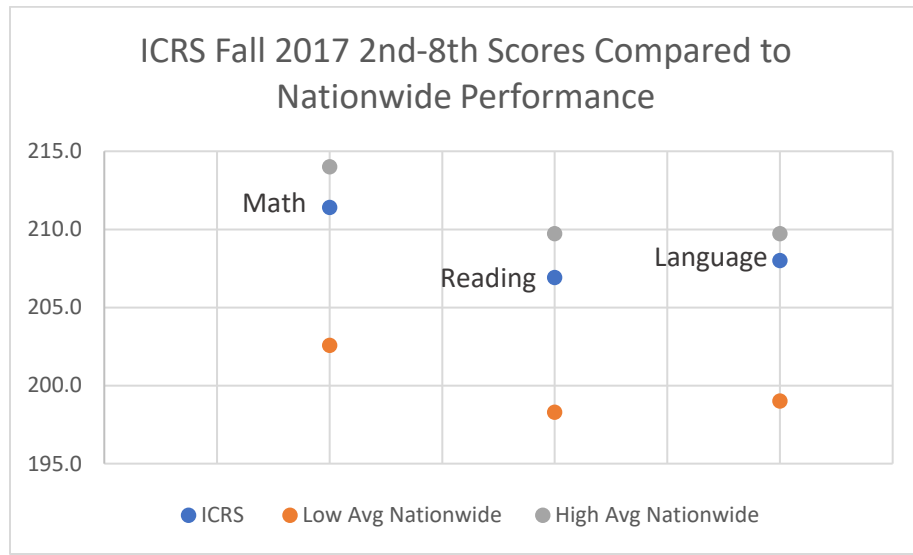
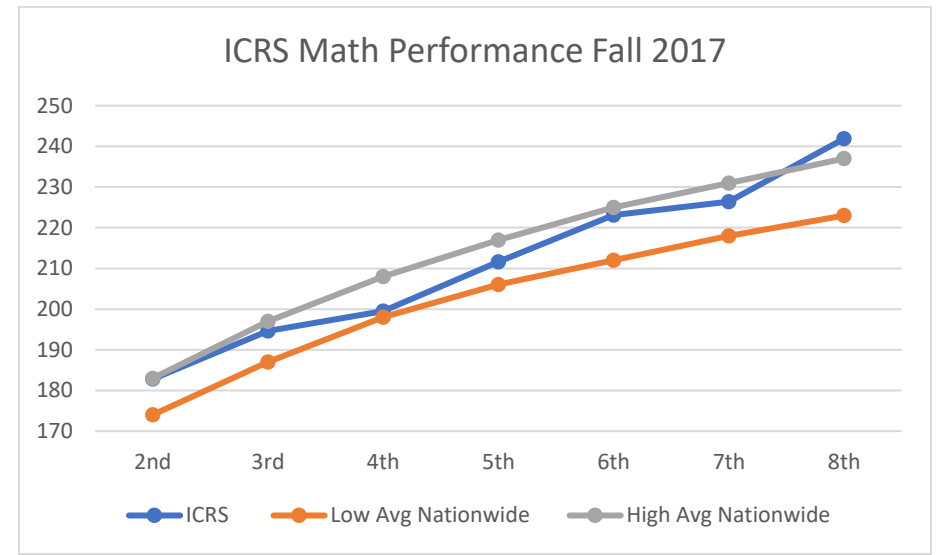


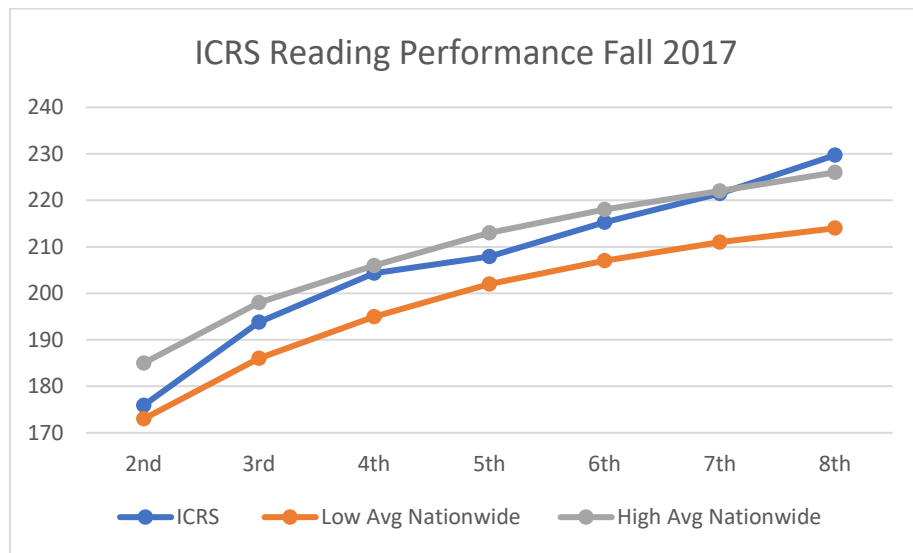
In the fall of 2017, ICRS 2nd-8th graders took the Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) test for the first time. The MAP test is an online adaptive test, and determines students' instructional readiness and academic goals, based on RIT (short for Rasch Unit) scores. The students will take the test again in the spring to showcase academic growth over the school year. The data below show how ICRS students performed in math, reading and language compared to students nationwide.



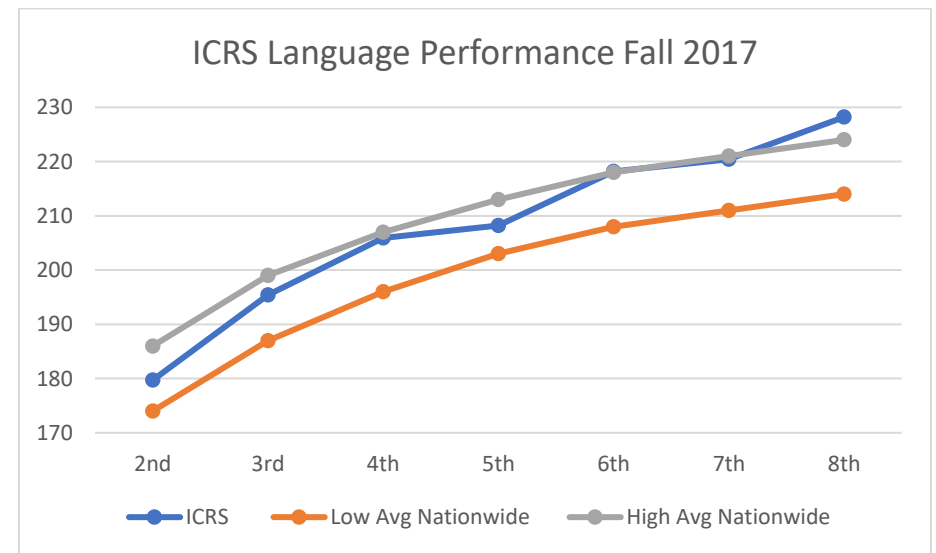
ICRS students perform in the high average range in math, reading, and language.



2nd, 3rd, 6th and 8th graders perform at or above high average in math.



4th, 7th and 8th graders perform at or above the high average range in reading.



4th, 6th, 7th, and 8th perform at or above high average in language.
