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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Students are bringing home their 1st Trimester report cards on Friday along with their personal reflection on one of the Schoolwide Learning Expectations (SLEs). The SLEs are engrained in our school culture as seen in service projects, family group activities, core learning, discipline, play, and study habits. By the time your child graduates from ICRS, they can
