That was very thoughtful of you and I appreciate it very much! We are moving along in our remote learning, and it is a pick up week for new packets. We are moving into Geometry for Math. Students will use objects from home rather than the classroom to make different objects. Students also have a book report that they can share on homeroom when completed. Students are receiving a list of the first grade sight words that they will be tested on. Students will each get to share what they are afraid of and may share a picture or short story. The second one will be on Thursday @ 9AM and that one will be a geometry theme. Students may share something they made with different shapes. It could be a picture, math page or object. I will add the names for show-n-tell with the links.
