A committee of health professionals, teachers, staff and parents is meeting weekly over the summer to plan for on-site education at ICRS this Fall 2020. The group is made up of four sub-committees, focused on the areas of Health and Wellness, Schedules, Technology and Communication. The committee will provide weekly updates to keep parents up-to-date on areas of discussion. Please note that due to the constant change to CDC demands, ICRS policies will not be finalized until August.



Health and Wellness

- Research mask or mask alternatives to meet CDC guidelines
- Healthy environment/response to sick person
- Social & emotional well being for students and teachers
- Examine possibilities of providing extracurricular options such as athletic teams, chess, Lego club, violin and world languages



Schedules

- · Weekly and daily schedule options
- Space in the different classrooms
- Determine which grades will get which rooms
- Interaction of kids in the classroom while meeting the six foot social distance requirement
- Assess current enrollment for each grade level
- Determine the role of specialists in the new school year



Technology

- Implement school-wide schedule for classroom/Zoom meetings if we have to go remote
- · Install filters for laptops to be used at home
- Create a user contract for technology that addresses appropriate use. This will go out before school starts
- Train students on appropriate use of technology, including how to access and turn in work online as needed
- Determine online platforms that will be used
- Research options to sync live-streaming with live class instruction



Communication

- One consistent message each week during the summer
- Post weekly message on ICRS website in English and Spanish
- · Communicate time-line for policy approval
- Explain difference between public school requirements and private school requirements for our parents
