SAFETY UPDATE

- I want all ICRS students and staff to be well and healthy and for the school to continue to
 provide in-person instruction. Please keep your children home if they are sick. As cold and flu
 season approaches, parents and staff have questions regarding symptoms. Refer to the DOH's
 COVID-19 Screening Flowchart for guidance. (CLICK HERE FOR LINK ON THE ICRS WEBSITE)
 - (Parent question) If a sibling has a cold, but no fever, does the child without symptoms need to stay home? What if the parent has a cold but the children do not have symptoms? (DOH response) Encourage testing of the child/parents with symptoms, the child/children without symptoms does not need to stay home but if the symptomatic child/parent turns out to be positive then siblings need to quarantine.
 - (Parent question) If the child has a cold, but no fever, how long do they need to stay home from school? (DOH response) As per the K-12 guidance, students with suspected signs of COVID-19 will need to stay out of school for 24 hours after symptoms resolve AND at least 10 days unless the child has a PCR test for COVID-19 and tests negative. With a negative test the child can return 24 hours after symptoms resolve. The best way to get the students back is to get tested to know whether they are positive or negative.
- Skagit County's COVID data remain low, currently in the low forties. We continue to focus
 on safety measures in the classroom and appreciate each of you doing your part to keep
 the numbers down.
