PARENT MEETING FOLLOW-UP

Thank you to the parents who participated in the Zoom meeting on October 26. We received several questions following the meeting. The questions that are not addressed below will be included in next week's message.

Parent Question: Why are scrip orders inconsistent this year? ICRS

must submit a minimum number of orders or the school loses money due to the cost of shipping gift cards. Rather than losing money, scrip orders will be deferred until the following week when more orders come in. If you have time sensitive order, please contact the school office to confirm that a sufficient amount of scrip has been ordered for the week. Additionally families can take advantage of ScripNow through the Raise Right app which offers instant access to electronic and printable gift cards.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- All volunteers and school employees must meet Archdiocesan Safe Environment requirements. The initial class is three hours and usually in person. Thereafter, volunteers have to update their Safe Environment requirements every three years online by watching a short video and taking a quiz. Renewal notices are sent via email. For first time volunteers, see <u>virtusonline.org</u> to sign up for in-person or online initial trainings.
- Lunch duty and recess duty volunteers are needed. Please contact <u>goropeza@icrsweb.org</u> to sign up. Volunteers must be current with their Safe Environment requirements.
- Weekend opportunity. One family is needed to stick dots on the playground to help students stand six feet apart during dismissal. Please contact **goropeza@icrsweb.org** to sign up.

HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATE

- Rainy day dismissal: As we approach the rainy season, we want to keep students dry and warm. Please make sure your child has a jacket on those days. Dismissal will look different. Students will remain in their rooms and be called over the PA system to board their cars. Rainy day dismissal will begin at 2:55 PM.
- Skagit County's COVID data reflects that we are at moderate risk, currently in the 50s. We
 continue to focus on safety measures in the classroom and appreciate each of you doing your
 part to keep the numbers down.
