VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

 Environment requirements every three years online by watching a short video and taking a quiz.

HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATE

- Skagit County's COVID data reflects that we are at high risk. In response to this data, the school
 improved social distancing during lunch and recess, and changed the format for school Mass, which
 we hosted via Zoom. We continue to focus on safety measures in the classroom and appreciate
 each of you doing your part to keep the numbers down.
- If your child is sick, please keep them home so we can continue to offer in-person learning. If your child has been exposed directly to a positive case of COVID-19, please keep them home for 14 days.
