VOLUNTEERS OPPORTUNITIES

- All volunteers and school employees must meet Archdiocesan Safe Environment requirements.
 The initial class is three hours and usually in person. Thereafter, volunteers update their Safe Environment requirements every three years online by watching a short video and taking a quiz.
 Renewal notices are sent via email. For first time volunteers, see <u>virtusonline.org</u> to sign up for in-person or online initial trainings. Principal Rodrigues is hosting "Protecting God's Children" class on Jan 11, 5:30-7:30pm via Zoom. Registered participants will receive an email the morning of the event with the Zoom link.
- We are seeking an immunization records keeper. Thank you to Robin Cully who has helped us with this project for the past two years. Contact the school office if you are interested.

HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATE

- Skagit County's COVID data reflects that we are at high risk. We continue to focus on safety measures in the classroom and appreciate each of you doing your part to keep the numbers down.
- If your child is sick or has been potentially exposed, please keep them home so we can continue to
 offer in-person learning. Here is What to do if you were potentially exposed to someone with
 a positive case of COVID-19 (Skagit Co DOH). Families, please notify me if your child has had
 direct contact with a positive case or if your child has tested positive COVID.
- All students, staff, and volunteers must wear their masks properly, which includes covering both your mouth and nose. Thank you for doing your part.
- **LUNCH ROOM**. ICRS students eat lunch in the lunchroom practicing the CDC safety protocols. The 5th-8th graders eat at 11:30, and the K-4th graders eat at noon. Children wear their masks when lining up, 6 feet apart, to wash their hands. They are seated six feet apart when eating, with cohorts spaced 8 feet apart. The north and south doors are opened to allow fresh air to circulate. After lunch, they line up, 6 ft apart, and return to class, wash their hands, and change their mask. Our HVAC units have filters changed twice a year (most recently in October.)
