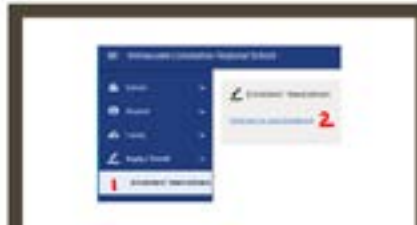

The Priority Enrollment window for returning families is coming to an end. We are expecting full classes next fall. All current ICRS families have priority registration from March 1-14. New families will begin enrolling on Monday, March 15 and will be able to reserve any available seats. Due to current waitlists in grades, we anticipate full classes this fall. Please register early. (Note that re-enrollment on RenWeb does not work on your cell phone.)

We currently have 31 “new student” applications already submitted for next fall. Please complete your re-enrollment today to secure your seat for next year.
