IN THE SPOTLIGHT

ICRS Endowment received a generous donation from the McPeake estate, \$525,000. These funds along with the funds raised from the ICRS 71st Anniversary will be deposited into the general endowment which contributes to the operating budget. The school will receive dividends from these donations after the 2021-2022 school year. As we continue to grow the general endowment (goal of \$10M), this fund will help ICRS retain excellent teachers and keep tuition affordable for all of our school families.



On May 17, The Knights of Columbus, Seattle, Council 676, donated another \$100,000 to support scholarships for ICRS students. The Endowment Board will explore avenues to make this a legacy gift, supporting tuition assistance for many years.

Thank you to the Knights of Columbus, Anacortes, and the Ray Wittman Scholarship Fund, who donated \$5,000 to support scholarships at ICRS. Scholarships are awarded to school families based on need. To be eligible for an ICRS scholarship, families must complete the Fulcrum Foundation tuition assistance application. This is the second year in a row we have received support from the Ray Wittman Scholarship Fund. We are very appreciative of their support of Catholic education!
