SCRIP sales summer calendar. Orders will be placed on the following Mondays during summer and available for pick up the following Friday.

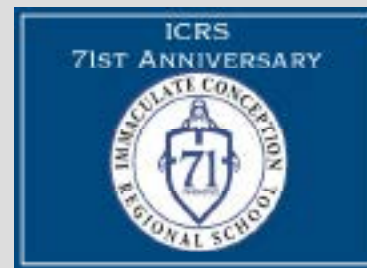
