COVID Updates: Learn to Return Program



ICRS follows the guidance of the governor, the local Dept of Health (DOH) and the Office of Catholic Schools (OCS) to provide a safe learning environment for students and staff and is committed to providing school in-person, five days a week. Guidance flexes with new information related to COVID. ICRS will continue a layered approach to support a safe learning environment. Below is information on **FREE COVID testing** available at ICRS for students, staff and members of their households.

LAUNCHING SOON. The school is participating in "Learn to Return," a free service of COVID testing on campus. The school will use the Curative test, a PCR test with a 48 to 72hour turn around for results. This is a diagnostic test for symptomatic individuals or those who have come in close contact with a person confirmed to have COVID-19. Consent forms went home in this week's brown envelope. This test is self-administered and observed by a trained ICRS staff person. Testing on-site is confidential. A negative result can support a 7-day quarantine.

Those who do not wish to participate on-site will be required to provide proof of a *lab* test administered elsewhere if such individuals are symptomatic or identified as a close contact. Without a *lab* test, symptomatic students and close contacts will have to isolate or quarantine for 10 to 14 days.
