COVID UPDATES: Masks Optional at Recess



ICRS follows the guidance of the governor, the local Dept of Health (DOH) and the Office of Catholic Schools (OCS) to provide a safe learning environment for students and staff and is committed to providing school in-person, five days a week. Guidance flexes with new information related to COVID. ICRS will continue a layered approach to support a safe learning environment. Below is information on optional masks during outdoor recess beginning Feb 28.

Step 1: Masks Optional at Outdoor Recesses

ICRS will transition into "masks-optional" during recess. Students can be mask-free while at outdoor recess beginning Monday, Feb 28. Families who prefer that their student wear a mask at recess, please have a conversation with your student. Duties will not be able to keep track of who should wear masks at recess. Most importantly, parents please remind your students that we respect each families' decision and support one another without judgment.

On February 17, 2022, Governor Jay Inslee announced that the statewide indoor mask requirement for Washington State, including schools, is scheduled to end on March 21, 2022. Students will still have to wear masks on buses. The DOH will update their school guidance. I look forward to sharing more information with you.

The best way to protect against COVID is to get vaccinated and to stay home if you are sick. The school policy is that a student has to be free of symptoms for 24 hours, without medication, prior to returning to school (assuming symptoms are not part of an ongoing medical condition).
