We hired Mrs. Malia Santucci, currently a Catholic school teacher in Edmonds. Mrs. Santucci will be our new 3rd grade teacher next fall. In preschool, Mrs. Marina Munoz will be our new lead teacher working with the PK team.

ICRS School Safety. ICRS secures its campus during school hours by locking perimeter gates and directing all parents and guests to enter campus at the front office. All parents and guests must sign in before they are admitted. As a small school, we are blessed to recognize and know parents and community members. New visitors are admitted with an appointment and a campus contact person. Our secure entrance limits accessibility to our campus.

To prepare for emergencies, students and staff practice drills—bus evacuation, fire, lockdown or earthquake drills. Students learn to recognize the “call” and “respond” appropriately, quickly and safely. ICRS works with Mount Vernon law enforcement to update our emergency responses. Teachers will participate in thorough safety training planned for August.

Teach the children: *“If you see something, say something.”* Children should tell an adult if they hear or see evidence of threatening behavior.

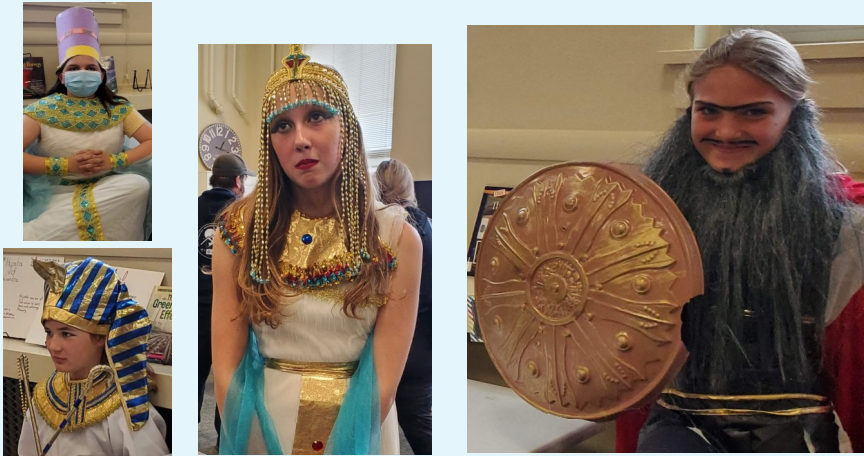
All school personnel and volunteers working with children must meet the Safe Environment Program requirements which include a background check and a class on “Protecting God's Children.”

Emergency Information: At registration time, parents provide emergency contact information on RenWeb, which designates how to contact them or their representative in case of an emergency. Parents are asked to update this information on RenWeb when changes occur, and to inform the school so it will know to print an updated form. In the event of an emergency, parents will be notified by text messaging and/or email.
