Happy summer! I wish you carefree days of fun and rest with your family. I do have a couple important summer topics to cover in this newsletter.




- 1. **Avoid the** *Summer Slide*. It is very important that your child does some academic review and learning this summer. The best thing is to read. Go to the library. Read together. Talk about books. Also, active math practice such as measuring and counting are very important. For example, when you are in the car, count by 10's, 5's, 7's, whatever. Let your child bake something; doubling or halving the recipe is great for developing fraction skills. Give your child a pile of change and ask them to sort and count it.
  - Teachers in the younger grades will be sending home summer packets. Please set a time every day for "summer school". Older grade students can read and use IXL or Kahn Academy.
- 2. Beware of the many dangers of screen time. I remember those days with my kids it's hard to set limits. Work with ALL of the adults in your child's life to decide limits and stay committed to enforcing them. Also, in the last week, I have had two cases of young children in our school who were exposed to sexual content in online games that are marketed to kids. Beware! Just because it is a "kid" game doesn't mean that bad actors don't have access to your children.

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3. Finally, thank you for making this a wonderful year. Our end-of-year survey showed that parents are mostly very happy with ICRS. Our finances are healthy, and our children have made great strides in growth this year. We are already planning for an even better year starting in September.
