All candidates must meet safe environment requirements. The staff at ICRS strive to help students become all that God has created them to be, and work as a team with one another, parents, students and administration.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS and JOB DESCRIPTION

- **Substitute Teachers.** Must have a bachelors degree and hold a valid credential, carry out lesson plans provided by teachers, communicate well with students and adults, teach effectively.
- **Substitute Instructional Aides.** Must have at least an AA degree, communicate well with students and adults, support teachers and administration as needed.
- **Substitute Hot Lunch Server.** Must have a valid Washington State Food Worker's Card (see: www.foodworkercard.wa.gov). This person will fill in as needed.

The MVSD prepares and delivers hot lunches to ICRS. The Hot Lunch Server prepares and serves lunch to students, and cleans up after each lunch. The server records daily food supply and communicates daily with the MVSD hot lunch program.
